■ PATCH DESIGN

NASA robotic engineering and space/aviation crews are teams where each member brings his/her strengths, talents, abilities, interests and achievements to the program. It has been a tradition in the space/aviation program for each crew to design a mission patch which represents the crew members individually, as well as collectively; in a way that also portrays the mission objectives.

As a part of this application process, we would like for you to design your own personal patch (must fit on 8-1/2" x 11" paper). Your patch should portray your talents, school and community activities in which you are involved, awards/honors you may have received, as well as any events in your life that have had an impact on family, school and/or other activities. The artistic design of the patch will **not** be a determining factor in scholarship selection, but, rather, the way the applicant is able to introduce himself/herself to us.

Please attach a description of the patch (no longer than one page) that includes explanations of symbols, colors, lettering, etc. Applicants may use computer technology to aid in patch design, but the medium chosen for the design will not be a determining factor in the scholarship selection.
